A reference is someone who can speak to your past performance, work habits, and skills. A potential employer may call or email them to ask questions about you during the application process.

CHOOSING REFERENCES

- References should, unless otherwise stated, be someone who knows you in a <u>professional</u> capacity, like a former supervisor or teacher. Do not use parents or friends as references.
- Ask individuals who will provide honest and positive recommendations.
- <u>Ask their permission</u>. Never assume some is okay with being a reference. Getting permission gives your reference notice and time to plan what they are going to say.
